



Footsteps for the Foundation

Thank you for participating in the Footsteps for the Foundation Walk and showing your support for the Urgent Care Foundation.

You should have received a T-shirt, pedometer, goody bag and walk ribbon when checking-in or registering on-site.

Your first step is to turn on your pedometer and clip it on. Wear your pedometer for the entire meeting – wherever you go, your pedometer will record your number of steps.

Remember, every step counts!

Official Rules:

- The walk officially begins when you check-in/register on-site (pick up your pedometer)
- Wear your pedometer wherever you go and do not erase your steps at any point
- Registration is allowed at any point during the convention
- Only the number of steps that appear on your pedometer when you record your steps will count
- **You must record your steps to be eligible for any drawings**
- All participants must record their steps at the Foundation table in the foyer area by **9am Thursday morning** to be eligible to win the giveaway prizes (staff and Trustees can participate, but can't win!)
- **Winners will be announced at the Closing General Session on Thursday at 10:45am – you must be present to win (remember to bring your ticket to general session)**

* Refunds will be issued only in the event you cancel your convention registration (cancellation policy is the same as registering for the convention)

** Will only add 5,000 steps if your pedometer resets to zero
